Amy Miguez: 11 out of 27 convenience stores sold cigarettes to minors. Enforcement - effort about ACME bar if they were in code, checked for underage drinkers. Would like to see more involvement from the businesses to be proactive in cracking down on binge drinking, underage drinking. Fake IDs are being turned in and reported to the police.

Fake ID scanners. Social media outreach during prom season – Parents who host the most, a link to HS video production – With graduations coming up another good time to have outreach. Tip line and county police officers did not report any house parties or underage drinking reports. Media Kits can be given to e shared on social media.

Kyle, works with Mayor office- provided a copy of all the laws and codes regarding underage drinking and Alcohol Beverage Control Board.
